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
AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy 4-12 months old \$225

Our AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy® program is the perfect first step for setting your puppy up for a lifetime of success. Over the course of 6 weeks, you and your pup will practice good manners, build healthy habits, and learn what responsible dog ownership looks like.

What to expect in class:

- For you: we'll cover responsible ownership keeping your pup healthy, providing exercise and play, bringing clean-up bags, and making sure they have ID.
- For your pup: we'll work on polite behavior like walking nicely on leash, tolerating grooming, being handled, and playing kindly with others.
- Pre-CGC Skills: puppies will also get a head start on Canine Good Citizen® basics, such as sit, down, come, staying calmly with another person, and handling distractions.

At the end, you'll not only have a happier, well-mannered pup, but you'll also earn your AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy® award and certificate — a great way to celebrate your dog's training journey!









Novice Obedience Any Age \$225

Novice Obedience is the next step for dogs who have mastered the basics and are ready to refine their skills. This class builds focus, reliability, and confidence in everyday situations — and helps your pup shine under distractions. What to expect in class:

- Leash skills figure 8 and heelwork on leash.
- Handling & manners stand for exam by a stranger, leave it, and out (drop high-value items).
- Reliable cues recall, long sits and downs, and place/kennel for extended periods.
- Focus under distractions practice skills even when the environment gets a little tricky.

By the end, your dog will have stronger obedience, better impulse control, and the confidence to follow cues in a variety of settings






Private Training 1 hour session \$125


Private Lessons give you and your dog focused, personalized training tailored to your goals! In this 1-hour session, we can work together in two ways:

- Owner-handled: you participate directly while I guide you and your dog through skills, behavior work, or problem-solving. By appointment.
- Day Training: your dog stays with me while you're away (during daycare or boarding) and I provide one-on-one focused training.

These sessions are perfect for dogs who need extra attention, want to learn new skills, or benefit from targeted behavior work — all in a supportive, flexible setting.











Our 30-minute Intro to Retrieves sessions are a fun way to introduce your dog to the basics of retrieving while at daycare or boarding!

Dogs will learn to wait beside their handler, fetch a dummy (up to 2 lbs), return to front, and deliver it to hand. The first class includes the purchase of a dummy, or article to be retrieved. This class is open to all breeds, though some, like spitz-type dogs, may need extra encouragement if holding objects isn't natural for them.

These short, focused sessions build focus, confidence, and teamwork — all in a positive, engaging environment.





Our 30-minute Intro to Scent sessions give your dog a fun outlet for their natural sniffing and tracking instincts while at daycare or boarding!

Dogs will be introduced to the basics of tracking and scent indication, learning to find essential oils, personal articles, or other items on request. These sessions focus on mental stimulation and focus — retrieval is not included.

Perfect for dogs who love to use their nose, these short, engaging sessions build confidence, focus, and provide a positive outlet for natural behaviors.
